**D**istinguished audience, I will like to note at this juncture that this event wouldn't have been possible without the cooperation of the students, unrelenting efforts and dedication of the staff, commitment of the leadership of the institution and the support of the State Government, under the leadership of the Visitor and Governor of Ogun State, His Excellency, Prince Dapo Abiodun, CON.

Therefore, I am so pleased to inform you that a total number of **6,209 undergraduates** [including **5,793 (regular)** and **416 (part-time)**] will convoke for the 2023/2024 Academic Session. In addition, a total of **741 postgraduates** would be conferred diplomas and degrees, comprising **571 PGD/Masters** and **170 PhD**.

The breakdown of the regular students category shows that **115** earned First Class (representing a **16.16%** increase on the total of 99 recorded for the 2022/2023 session), **1,845** were in the Second Class Upper Division, **3044** were in the Second Class Lower Division and **688** had Third Class Degree, **35** had a Pass Grade, while **66** (unclassified) graduated from our medical programme. The breakdown on faculty basis, is as given below.

## Breakdown of Regular Graduating Students in 2023/2024 Academic Session

The University has added twenty new programmes to its pool of academic disciplines, thereby increasing the options available to prospective undergraduates and postgraduates. We have also maintained Full Accreditation status in all our programmes.

The highpoints of this programme will be the Convocation Lecture titled: "TETFund and Educational Development in Nigeria: The History, the Treasures and the Future" to be delivered by the Executive Secretary, TETFund – Architect Sunny S.T. Echono, and the conferment of Honorary Degree of Doctor of Science on a globally acclaimed Consultant Ophthalmic Surgeon and the Chief Medical Director, Eye Foundation Hospital Group, in person of Dr. Adekunle Olubola Hassan on Friday, 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2025.

This great institution is poised to give our students the best experience, while molding them to be outstanding both in learning and character. As encapsulated in our 3Es Concept, we have made it a point of duty that our graduates should be able to further their education; skillful enough to be gainfully employed in both public and private sectors; and also greatly knowledgeable to become employers of labour through entrepreneurship. We also inculcate in them the virtues of 'a gentleman' as enshrined in our Logo boldly depicted with the Navy Blue colour.

We have also continued to demonstrate the shining star that we are by keying into evolving trends in teaching and research technologies. Just recently, Olabisi Onabanjo University was crowned the "AI School of the Year" at the 2024 Data Science Nigeria (DSN) annual boot camp event, including a star prize of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) worth of books. Two of our Lecturers also emerged as joint winners of the inaugural Google Academic Research Awards (GARA) for 2024. The award included a research grant of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000).

We have equally improved on the engagement of our **Alumni**, which has really paid off. Some have singlehandedly donated structures to the University, including Bar Segun Asekun Law Resource Centre; Alhaji Lawal Fagbo Saheed 750-Seater Lecture Theatre, FAMS; and Otunba Olufemi Okenla Entrepreneurship Centre that is nearing completion. A good number of the Alumini Chapters and Sets have also supported us in diverse areas, including the Remodeling of the University Main Gate, Ago-Iwoye by the UK Chapter; renovation of the Glass House, OACHS, Sagamu by the 1999 Set of Graduating Doctors; Donation of Public Address Systems by Abeokuta Chapter, to mention but a few.

Also noteworthy are the invaluable support the University has continued to receive from the Awujale of Ijebu Land, HRM Oba Sikiru Kayode Adetona, GCON and other renown philanthropists, including Alhaji (Dr.) Sulaiman Adebola Adegunwa, OFR and many others, who have sustainably identified with the University in the pursuit of its Mission and Vision.

**D**istinguished Gentlemen of the Press, may I also inform you that His Excellency, the Governor of Ogun State, Prince Dapo Abiodun, CON, will be Special Guest of Honour at this occasion which is expected to attract dignitaries including Scholars, Vice-Chancellors from sister Universities and eminent Nigerians from all walks of life.
